BUILD BETTER BONES

Osteoporosis is a decrease in bone density that cause skeletal weakness. Prior to the 1970's, osteoporosis was considered rare and was only diagnosed in the elderly after a fracture. Today, this problem has become epidemic in both the United States and many European countries. The common belief is that we aren't getting enough calcium in our diets. However, if that were actually the case, then all the dairy products, calcium-fortified foods, calcium-based antacids and calcium supplements would be fixing the problem. Health and Safety Help from Aurora Health Center in Reedsville

Question: My child plans to participate in sports this fall.
What steps should I take to prevent injuries?

Answer: Children who participate in sports are improving their physical fitness, motor skills, self-esteem and social skills including teamwork and leadership. But, there are risks with children in sports and parents can take steps to protect their child from injury.

Sports-related injuries can be prevented by:

- Using proper protective equipment and safety gear, including a helmet, goggles, pads, mouth guards and athletic cups.
 - Checking the maintenance and safety of the playing surface.
 - Requiring appropriate adult supervision.
- Preparing a child how to play a sport and showing the importance of following the rules of the game. Preparation also includes warming-up muscles and practicing before games.

Children with serious injuries should be taken to the emergency room. Your family doctor or nurse practitioner can help with other common injuries such as minor sprains and strains or overuse injuries like shin splints. He or she will diagnose an injury by taking a medical history, examining the child and ordering some routine tests.

Diagnosing potential problems sooner than later will help prevent a chronic condition from occurring and will get your child back in the game quicker.

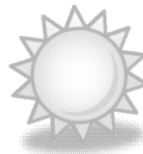
